What was Life like for a Victorian Child?

Science

We will learn about evolution and inheritance (linked to 'Mary Anning - Victorian fossil hunter'), living things and their habitats and classifying plants and animals

History

Languages

Geography

We will use field work to observe, measure and report the human and physical features in the local area (Home Farm) using a range of methods

We will use search technologies effectively, select, use and combine a variety of software. Discuss how to use technology safely and respectfully and identify a range of ways to report concerns

We will play and perform using our voices, improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the 'Charanga' website

DT & Art

To understand seasonality and know how and where ingredients are grown. Know about healthy eating.
