As the topic develops it will follow the children's natural curiosities and be led by pupil voice.



Science

This term, we will be exploring and using classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in the world around us. We will also investigate how and why the environment can change and how this affects the animals around us.

Art and Design

In Art, we will be exploring artist from other cultures; we will create sketchbooks to record our observations and continue to develop our art and design skills, including drawing and painting with a range of materials.

Computing

We will learn about communicating safely online and use a range of software and hardware to perform digital tasks. The children will learn how to design, write and debug a program.

Design Technology

We will be tasting food from around the world and learning how to make and prepare food from other cultures.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about what life is like in different countries and major cities. The children will use maps and atlases to identify different countries, describe, and understand key aspects of physical geography, including rivers, mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes.

History

We will be learning about key events from other countries in chronological order and terms such as 'empire', 'civilisation', 'parliament' and 'peasantry'.

Music

We will be learning to appreciate and understand a wide range of live and recorded music from different cultures, as well as developing our understanding of the history of music.

Personal, Social, Health and Relationship and Citizenship

We will be learning how to be a good friend and be a good worldwide citizen. In addition, we will explore the principals behind democracy.

Physical Education

In PE we will be learning to confidently swim 25 metres, use a range of strokes and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.

Religious Education

This term, we will learn about a range of religions, special people and special places. We will have time to reflect and share our own ideas, thoughts and opinions.
